

PVC SCH40 Installation Instructions

EASY STEPS FOR INSTALLING PVC SCH40 FITTINGS

- 1. Measure and mark the PVC pipe where you will be installing the fittings. Use the measuring tape to get accurate measurements, and mark the pipe with a marker.
- 2. Cut the PVC pipe to the desired length using the PVC pipe cutters or a saw. Make sure to cut the pipe as straight as possible to ensure a secure fit.
- 3. Deburr the cut.
- **4.** Use the PVC primer on the outside of the pipe and the inside of the fitting. Apply the primer using a clean cloth, and make sure to cover the entire surface.
- **5.** Apply the PVC cement to the outside of the pipe and the inside of the fitting. Be sure to apply the cement evenly and cover the entire surface.
- 6. Quickly insert the fitting onto the pipe, twisting it slightly to ensure a tight fit. Hold the fitting in place for 30 seconds to allow the cement to dry.
- **7.** Repeat the above steps for each additional fitting that needs to be installed.
- 8. Allow the cement to dry completely. This may take several hours depending on the temperature and humidity.
- 9. Test the fittings to make sure they are secure and leak-free. Turn on the water supply and inspect the fittings for any leaks or signs of damage.
- 10. If necessary, make any adjustments or repairs to ensure a secure and leak-free installation.





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
